Q1 How do students get leadership opportunities?

There are various leadership roles available in the classroom, including Class Leaders, ICT Monitors, PE Monitors, and Group Leaders. Each year, form teachers identify potential student leaders based on their attitude and aptitude. The aim is to provide every student an opportunity to experience a leadership role by the end of Primary 6. Those who demonstrate strong leadership competencies are nurtured further to become Ambassadors, Prefects, or CCA Leaders. Their leadership skills are further developed through internal and external leadership programs. Student leaders are also given opportunities to hone their leadership skills at various platforms.
