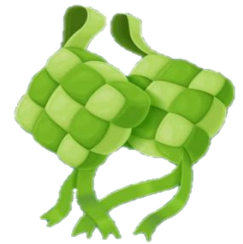

Dear Parents / Guardians,

1. Hari Raya Celebrations & Fringe Activities

Students will participate in Hari Raya festive celebrations and fringe activities during assembly and recess time on **3 April**.

Students celebrating Hari Raya are encouraged to come to school dressed in Malay ethnic attire. Do note that with the ethnic attire, hair accessories must still be in accordance with school rules and school shoes must be worn.



2. International Friendship Day

International Friendship Day (IFD) is commemorated annually in schools. It is a day dedicated to understanding the importance of Singapore maintaining its international space and good relations with neighbouring countries.

The theme for IFD this year is "Forging Friendships In A Complex World". While the rapidly evolving global landscape offers Singapore both opportunities and challenges, international cooperation remains vital for us to address global issues collectively and seize new opportunities. By fostering an appreciation of different cultures and perspectives, students will be better equipped to contribute to a cohesive and globally connected society; and forge meaningful connections with our neighbours and help Singapore remain relevant in a complex world. In addition, they can embrace openness and opportunities for international cooperation, while deepening their understanding of Singapore's geopolitical realities and national interests.



As part of its Character and Citizenship Education (CCE) Programme to develop cross-cultural skills and a global orientation, the school will commemorate IFD with a series of exciting fringe activities through mass assembly and fringe activities during recess from **10 to 11 April 2025**. Through these activities, we hope to acquaint our students with the diverse and colourful cultures and traditions of the region and the lives of their peers in the other ASEAN countries; interact respectfully with people from other countries to understand others' culture and lives; as well as express an appreciation of the contributions of the people from Asia and beyond living, working, and studying in Singapore.

3. P3 – P5 Weighted Assessment 1 (WA1)

The schedule and topics to be assessed for the Weighted Assessment 1 have been sent via Parent Gateway on 28 February and 3 March. P3 to P5 parents are to refer to the same notification to understand the guidelines on absence during Weighted Assessment.

Note:

P1 and P2 students will not be sitting for Weighted Assessment. Instead, they will be assessed holistically through bite-size assessments for different areas of development. Parents will receive feedback on their learning progress.

4. Earth Day

The theme for Earth Day 2025 is “**Invest in Our Planet**”. This theme highlights the importance of investing in sustainable solutions and taking actions to ensure a healthy and thriving planet for future generations. It encourages individuals and their communities to make choices that prioritize the well-being of the environment.

During the Earth Day, which falls on **22 April**, the Environmental Awareness and Education Team of teachers and our pupil Environment Ambassadors would spend a week to share tips and programmes with the school. We hope the students would be able to pick up good practices and internalise them into their daily life activities.

There are also many simple and fun ways to get involved! The children can start by picking up litter around their school or neighborhood, plant a tree or flowers to help the environment, or even start recycling at home. Learning about how to save water, turn off lights when not in use, and conserve energy are also great ways to take care of the Earth.

By doing these small actions, everyone can make a big difference in keeping our planet clean and healthy for the future!

5. P6 Oral Practice Sessions

Primary 6 students will be having English and Mother Tongue Languages Oral Practice Sessions on **28 and 29 April** to help them familiarize with the oral assessment and its procedures. After the sessions, feedback will be given to students to help them improve their oral skills. The sessions will be held after school in the afternoon. Details will be sent out to parents and guardians nearer the date of the practice sessions.

There will be no remedial lesson for all levels on that day.
