Dear Parents / Guardians,

1. Total Defence Day Commemoration



Singapore marks Total Defence Day (TDD) on Feb 15 every year. It is the date Singapore fell to the Japanese in 1942. This year, TDD is commemorated national wide on Monday, 17 Feb. Total Defence Day reminds us that resilience and the ability to be prepared for and overcome crises and challenges are a key part of who we are as Singaporeans. To encourage students to develop and value this resilience, schools can participate in the nationwide Exercise SG Ready (ESR25).

As part of our school's commemoration of Total Defence Day and participation in Exercise SG Ready 2025, our students will experience a power disruption simulation. This disruption exercise aims to prepare students for potential disruptions to our power supply (e.g., due to supply chain disruptions), given Singapore's reliance on fuel imports. In such a situation, electricity may have to be prioritised for more critical areas, and households and organisations, including schools, may have to endure disruptions in their power supply. Following the exercise, students will reflect on their experience and share their thoughts and feelings with their classmates through a guided discussion. More information about this exercise will be shared through PG nearer Total Defence Day Commemoration.

2. Chinese New Year Celebrations

Students will participate in CNY festive celebrations on Tuesday, 28 January 2025, which include concert programme and classroom activities. Students will be dismissed at 10.30am on that day.



Students celebrating CNY are encouraged to come to school dressed in Chinese ethnic attire. Do note that with the ethnic attire, hair accessories must still be in accordance with school rules and school shoes and socks must be worn.
