### P6 Mid-Year Examination (MYE) Matters – Absence from Examinations

Please note that if your child is absent for any paper during MYE, his/her absence must be supported with a letter from parents with official supporting documents to be considered as 'Absent with Valid Reason'.

We appeal to parents to exercise personal responsibility and refrain from sending your child to school if he/she is unwell or has been certified by a doctor to be unfit for attendance in school. A child who is unwell will not perform at his/her best.

Once your child returns to school, the subject teacher will arrange for him/her to sit for the paper for the purpose of revision and practice. The teacher will mark the paper and give your child feedback on his/her performance. The marks for the paper will not be included in the overall results at the end of the year. However, the school will make the necessary adjustments to ensure that his/her year-end results are fair and valid.

## Updates on COVID-19 Matters (wef 26 Apr 2022)

Dear Parents, in line with the further easing of community SMMs announced on Friday 22 Apr 2022, do take note of the implication of the revised SMM for schools:

### Group Size

- No group size limit.

### Mask-Wearing

- Required indoors (e.g., hall, library, classroom, canteen, school bus) as a default.
- Optional outdoors (e.g., parade square, school field, unenclosed corridor).

### Safe Distancing

- No safe distancing requirement between groups for mask-off activities

### Capacity Limits

- No capacity limits;
- No zoning requirements; and
- If mask-on, no restrictions on intermingling within/across schools and with public (MK children: no intermingling across levels or MKs)

### Stepping down of TraceTogether (TT) and SafeEntry (SE)

SE check-ins in schools are no longer required. Students are strongly encouraged to hold on to their TT tokens, so that we may rapidly step-up contact tracing and Vaccinated-Differentiated SMMs (VDS) checks should these be needed, e.g., in the event of the next Variant of Concern.

### Mid-Year Holidays Travel Declaration

Our school are adjusting our current practices and processes in accordance with the latest SMMs and will communicate with you separately to update you on the key changes, including submission of mid-year holidays travel declaration. Do keep a lookout via Parents Gateway.
