## Edusave Character Award (ECHA) 2023

MOE introduced the ECHA in 2012 to enable schools to recognise students who demonstrate exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions. The award also supports schools' continuing efforts in nurturing students of good values and character, who are active contributors and concerned citizens. ECHA is awarded for students' real-life demonstration of character and good values in the year of the award.

ECHA Nomination Criteria:

- Student must be a Singapore Citizen;
- Demonstrate exemplary and consistent behaviour;
- Possess a high level of civic responsibility and/or qualities associated with resilience.

ECHA recipients will be chosen through a rigorous, robust and fair selection process based on the guidelines and criteria provided by MOE. The 4 main stages in the selection process are:

- a) nomination;
- b) shortlisting of nominees by level teachers;
- c) selection of the final awardees by a panel headed by the VP; and
- d) endorsement by the Principal & representatives from key stakeholders.

In addition to the MOE Edusave Character Award, the school will continue to recognise students who are good role models with school-based awards such as the JYPS Character Award. These awardees will be selected based on similar criteria for ECHA and would include non-Singaporeans.

## GIFTED EDUCATION PROGRAMME (GEP) 2024

The Ministry of Education is carrying out the identification of pupils for the Gifted Education Programme 2024. There are two stages – **Screening and Selection** – for this identification exercise. The **Screening** exercise for P3 Junyuan Primary students will be held in school during curriculum time on **Thursday 17 August 2023**. Pupils will be asked to work on English Language and Mathematics questions at the following times:

English Language : 8.15 a.m. – 9.30 a.m. (1 hr 15 min)

Mathematics : 10.30 a.m. – 11.45 a.m. (1 hr 15 min)

School hours on 17 August 2023 are as usual as it is a normal school day for all other levels.

Pupils' participation in the Screening exercise is not compulsory; however, we encourage you to allow your child to take part. Pupils will be given a recess break in between the English and Mathematics papers.

Pupils who are shortlisted to participate in the **Selection** exercise will be informed through the school in early October. The Selection exercise will be held on **17 and 18 October 2023**. Shortlisted pupils who are interested should make themselves available on both days.

A notification has been sent via Parents Gateway on 21 July, Friday. If you have not responded to the notification, please do so by **4 Aug, Friday**.

P3 Students who have chosen not to participate will still attend school as usual on Thursday, 17 August 2023.
